## **PRESIDENT'S REPORT FOR 2014**

1. Gentlemen, it gives me great pleasure to welcome you to the second meeting of the present Council. It is my privilege to present the report of the Institution for 2014. A copy of the report has been placed on the table and will be included in the minutes of the meeting.

#### **Finances**

2. Audit Report, Revised Estimates for 2014-15, and Budget Estimates for 2015-16 are already with you. Balance Sheet has been placed on the table.

3. Due to fall in number of officers enrolling for courses there has been a fall in income. Some heavy expenditure was approved on account of replacement of two Air Handling Units and photocopier as also on account of repair of the office burnt in fire incident on 14 Aug 2014. As the Research Centres are still not able to meet their expenditure from their yearly income these are allocated money from the Corpus Fund annually as decided by the Council.

4. The membership continues to grow at a steady rate. As on 15 Dec 2014 the membership state was as under:-

#### **USI Journal**

5. The Journal continues to be published uninterruptedly since 1871. The Journal is sent to all members. In addition, 463 copies are currently being subscribed, including 20 year subscription by 77 units.

#### **Library**

6. During the period 01 Nov 2013 – 31 Oct 2014, 226 books were purchased, 43 received for review, and 225 received complimentary.

#### <u>Seminars</u>

7. <u>Seminar on Afghanistan and Central Asia.</u> It was conducted on 11 – 12 Sep 2014 jointly with Near East South Asia Center for Strategic Studies (NESA), NDU, USA. Participants from seven countries attended.

8. <u>Thirty Fifth National Security Seminar.</u> It was conducted on 13-14 Nov 2014 on "Indian Ocean Region : Emerging Strategic Cooperation, Competition And Conflict Scenarios". Admiral RK Dhowan, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, ADC, Chief of Naval Staff delivered the Keynote Address. Air Chief Marshal Arup Raha, PVSM, AVSM, VM, ADC, Chairman COSC & Chief of Air Staff also attended the Inaugural Session. Proceedings are being compiled for publication.

#### Lectures and Discussions

9. <u>Twelfth Maj Gen Samir Sinha Memorial Lecture</u>. This was delivered by Rear Adm KR Menon (Retd) on 28 Jul 2014 on the subject "Concept and Application of Smart Power in Promoting India's National Interests and Strategic Objectives" and has been published in the USI Journal for Jul – Sep 2014.

10. <u>Eighteenth Col Pyara Lal Memorial Lecture.</u> This was delivered by Shri Shyam Saran, former Foreign Secretary, on 12 Sep 2014 on "Revamping India's National Security Architecture for Optimum Synergy in the Use of its Instruments of National Power". The text is being published in the USI Journal for Oct – Dec 2014.

11. <u>Thirtieth National Security Lecture.</u> This was delivered on 03 Dec 2014 by General VP Malik, PVSM, AVSM (Retd) on "A Comprehensive Response Strategy to a Collusive and Collaborative Threat from China and Pakistan". The text is being published in the USI Journal for Oct – Dec 2014.

13. The Thirtieth National Security Paper on "China-Russia-India : The Making of a Strategic Partnership " is being written by Shri Ajai Malhotra, IFS (Retd).

#### **Interaction With Foreign Institutions**

14. Institute of Defense Strategic Studies and Institute for Defence International Relations, Vietnam. A USI delegation led by Air Mshl AK Singh visited Vietnam from 25 to 31 May 2014.

15. <u>5th India – Japan – USA Trilateral Meeting : 18 – 19 Jun 2014.</u> The 5th trilateral meeting between the USI, Vanderbilt University, USA and Okazaki Institute, Japan was held at the Marine Corps University, Quantico, USA. The USI delegation also took this opportunity to participate in discussions at the Johns Hopkins University, and the Stimson Center, Washington D.C.

16. <u>Center for Strategic Studies, NDU, USA.</u> Dr Roger Kangas, Academic Dean alongwith his delegation visited the USI on 09 Sep 2014 and discussed modalities for continuing the dialogue between the USI and the NDU. The NDU jointly conducted a Seminar at the USI this year and would like the USI delegation to visit NDU in the year 2015.

17. <u>National Defence College, Muscat, Oman.</u> A delegation led by Brig Gen Awadh Bin Mohd Bin Said Al-Mashaikhi visited USI on 13 - 14 Oct 2014 and discussed USI-NDC, Oman Collaboration. It was decided that the USI will conduct some lectures at NDC, Oman and also participate in each other's seminars etc.

18. <u>Bangladesh Institute of Peace and Security Studies (BIPSS) Dhaka.</u> <u>Bangladesh.</u> Maj Gen ANM Muniruzzaman, President BIPSS met the Director on 10 Nov 2014. He fondly recalled his earlier visit with BIPSS delegation to USI in 2009 and was happy to be back in USI to participate in the National Security Seminar 2014. He invited the USI delegation to visit Dhaka in 2015, details of which can be worked out.

19. International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS) London. Mr Rahul Roy Chaudhury, Senior Fellow for South Asia called on the Director on 11 Nov 2014 and discussed the ongoing joint USI / IISS nuclear workshop and to participate in each other's international workshops / seminars. The 3<sup>rd</sup> USI – IISS Nuclear Workshop will be held in 2015 at a mutually convenient date.

20. <u>Institute for Defence Strategy (IDS), Ministry of National Defence, Vietnam.</u> Lt Gen (Dr) Nguyen Duc Hai, Director General IDS alongwith Lt Col Nguyen The Hong, Head of Asia-Africa Division, IDIR called on the Director on 13 Nov 2014. They expressed great satisfaction at the relations between USI and the IDS and IDIR and hoped that the yearly bilateral visits and discussion will continue to grow in the coming years.

21. <u>National Defence College, Dhaka, Bangladesh.</u> Lt Gen MF Akbar participated in the USI National Security Seminar on 13 – 14 Nov and discussed future cooperation between the two Institutions. He extended an invitation to the Director to visit NDC, Dhaka and deliver a talk.

22. <u>Tamkang University, Taipei, Taiwan.</u> Dr Kaocheng Wang, Dean of College of International Studies Tamkang University visited the USI on 14 Nov 2014 and discussed the possibilities of cooperation between our two Institutions. He invited USI experts visiting Taipei to visit his college and deliver talks on subjects of mutual interest.

23. <u>China Institute of International Strategic Studies (CIISS).</u> A delegation led by Maj Gen Zhu Da visited USI from 30 Nov to 04 Dec 2014. The delegation also interacted with Vivekanand Foundation and called on the CISC. Maj Gen Da extended an invitation to the USI delegation to visit China in 2015.

24. Korea National Defense University (KNDU). Dr Yong-Sup Han, Vice President of KNDU and President, Korea Nuclear Policy Society visited the USI on 17 Dec 2014 and discussed bilateral relations between KNDU and USI. He was happy that there was interaction between the two institutions but suggested that we participate annually in each others national seminars and if possible sign an MOU. The Director suggested that we could also jointly work on a research project which Dr Han agreed to and suggested that we work out the modalities for it.

25. <u>Indonesian Defense University.</u> An IDU delegation led by Air Vice Marshal Suparman Djapri, Vice Rector visited the USI to discuss modalities for cooperation between the IDU and the USI. After discussions, AVM Djapri expressed his desire that the USI conduct lectures and capsules for the IDU for which modalities can be jointly work out. The Director agreed to the proposal.

#### **<u>42.</u>** Events Connected with "India and the Great War" Centenary Commemoration <u>Project</u>

43. Various events are planned over the period 2014-18, highlighting Indian contribution, in collaboration with various countries. The project is being supported by MEA amongst others. Following events have been conducted:-

(a) <u>Jaipur Literary Festival</u>. A panel discussion was organised during the festival (17-21 Jan 2014) on WWI, wherein Sqn Ldr Rana TS Chhina highlighted the contribution of Indian Armed Forces.

(b) <u>**Talk at USI.**</u> Ms Jody East, Curator of Royal Pavilion and Museum Brighton, gave a talk on 05 Feb 2014 on "The Royal Pavilion Brighton and its Indian Connection with the Great War".

(c) <u>Talk at Chandimandir.</u> Talk by Ms Jody East at HQ Western Command on 07 Feb 2014.

(d) <u>International Conference at Dhaka.</u> The conference and an exhibition was organised by Alliance Francoise de Dhaka on 24-26 Feb 2014. Theme was "War and Colonies 1914-18". Sqn Ldr Rana TS Chhina presented a paper on "Bhadralok Warriors: The Bengali Military Experience in the Great War". He also presided over a session.

(e) <u>Media Discussion</u>. A media discussion was organised jointly by USI and Australian High Commission on 03 Mar 2014 on "A Century of Shared Defence Cooperations between Australia and India". (f) International Conference at USI : 05 to 07 Mar 2014.
